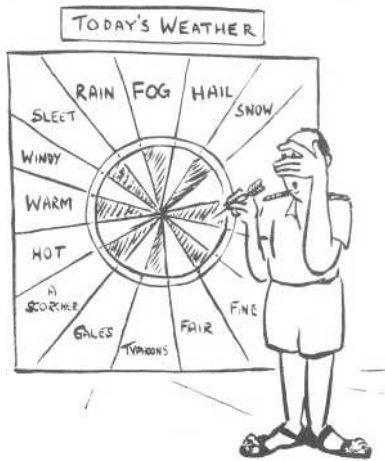


METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT

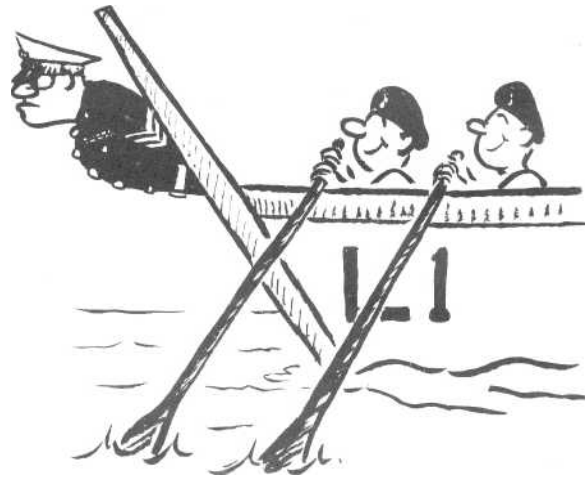
Whether we be judged from meteorological or news considerations, we hope the verdict will be "Informative, occasionally amusing".

ROYAL MARINES

Per Mare Per Terram Per Albion

Ever since December 1962, the complete Detachment has rarely been on board - somebody has always been ashore in Borneo, so it would be hard to tell the whole story in these few lines.

Of our three sections, the Signallers have probably had it most rugged. At Brunei, it started when a couple went ashore as helicopter control team.



But soon, Albion operations expanded and our signallers were busy establishing radio coverage over our whole area of helicopter work. As *Albion's* squadrons have virtually pioneered helicopter operations in Borneo, so our signallers have built



up a most efficient wireless network in all the helicoptering areas.

At the time of going to press our "Men in Borneo" are situated at Sibul, Nanga-Gaot and Tawau, but we expect them back soon. They have to their credit the control stations (now R.A.F. or Royal Signals owned) at Kuching, Simanggang, and Brunei.

The Landing Craft section have mainly worked transferring the units from *Albion* either to shore, or to CMS and other small vessels suitable for the river journey to the troop destinations, (sometimes eighty miles away).

Squadron movements have always needed LCA's to carry the vast bulk of the ground equipment, rocketry and stores, to and from the oasis.

At Tawau and Labuan (for Brunei) the journey was a mere couple of miles, but at Kuching, where 845 and 846 have been landed and recovered twice, it has meant fifty-six-mile round journeys.

The LCA's have been detached twice to operate from shore; Brunei (eight weeks), and Tawau (a fortnight), and if it were not for African events, they'd still be there. When inshore and up river, the LCA's have often been the only way to keep forward troops and helicopters in food, ammunition, stores and fuel.

Last but not least, the third section which is the Assault Supply section and Detachment HQ. They had a lot of hard work and none of the glory of the forward areas, and their splendid efforts have justly been praised by everyone they worked with - ship, commandos, army units and squadrons.

Church life in H.M.S. *Albion* has, during the commission, gone on in much the same way as it always has, down through the ages, in Churches



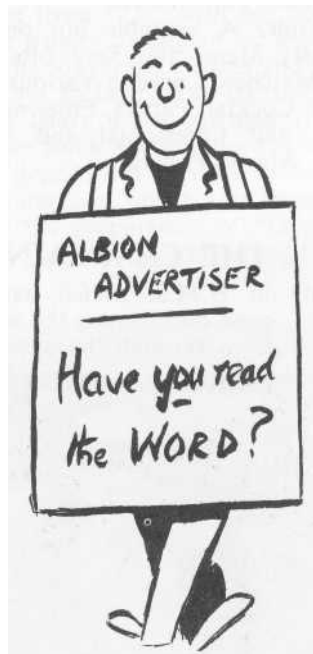

by repeating the importance of attendance at the Holy Communion. It is my conviction that it is only in that Service that we can experience the Power of the Living God - your Saviour and mine.

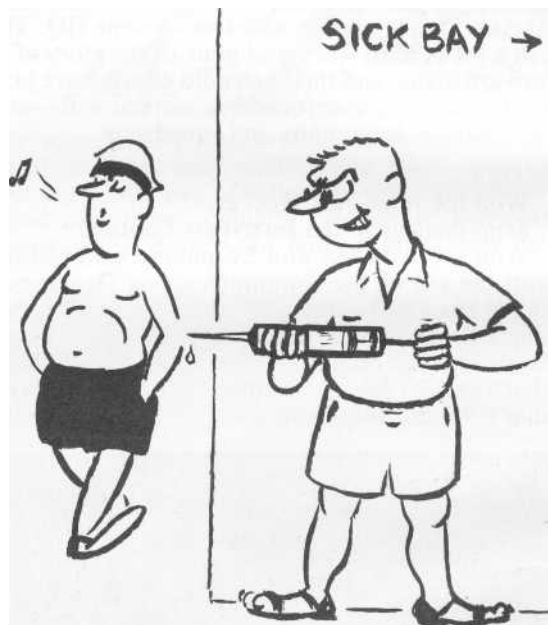
"God Bless you all".

MEDICAL AND DENTAL

Our small staff has had plenty of variety this commission from "ailments" to surgery. During the Brunei revolt we saw our first patients from the other Services, and have been looking hard at them ever since. We became so popular that even wounded rebels were "persuaded" to try us.

We used the operating theatre quite often and operated on forty major and one hundred and thirty minor cases. We held E.N.T. clinics for other ships and establishments including the Kuching General Hospital.

We all went sporting in some way. S.B.P.O. McCormack and L.S.B.A. Davis represented the ship at cricket and water polo. "George" represented himself at less orthodox but equally enjoyable shoreside sports. Another sick bay sport - the



evergreen "jab game" was played. We won, 7,000-Nil.

Dental. With a modernised Surgery and S.B.P.O. Coote standing by, we carried out routine treatments for the Albions, made liaison visits, and had Dental operating sessions in B.M.H. Singapore. Treatment for embarked units proved more difficult, and demanded a fluent knowledge of the word "toothache" in Gurkhali, Malay, King's Own Yorkshire and Queen's Own Scottish!

SPORTING

Albion goes marching on. The White Hart Lane cry rings round the ground at Terror, and *Albion* have scored another goal. Probably one of the 240 scored by the first eleven in fifty-one matches in ten months on the station.

This record speaks for itself but there is no need to remind anyone of the team which, now, is only a memory and perhaps a legend in Navy Football.

It was very encouraging to see people taking up new pastimes, such as Golf, Squash and Tennis. Sometimes it has been nearly crippling financially to buy another two rackets or so, but satisfying to see the gear used so much. Luckily, the Tombola profit covered the laundering of sports gear, otherwise we would have been playing in grass skirts.

One or two "never played before" people are now regular members of the Rugger 1st XV which has been enjoying some high class fixtures, but lack of experience has not allowed the results to run *Albion's* way too much.

Cricket has been a difficult sport to keep going with any continuity, as the ship has to be in the right place at the right time. In spite of this, the 1st XI have enjoyed a fairly successful season in the field and at the bar.

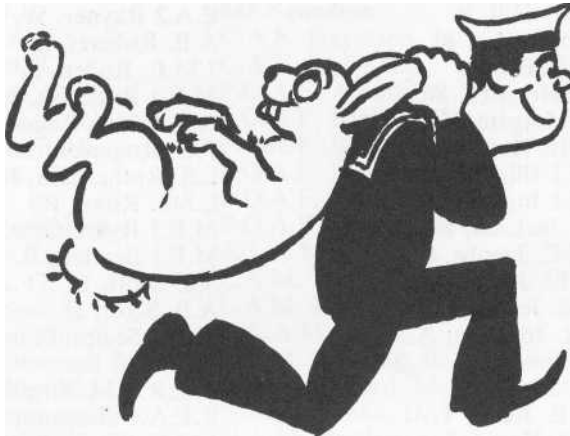
